Body Business is an interactive performance and installation exploring, expanding and re-envisioning the economic practices of the dance world. Body Business moves audiences to consider an economy that values artists' creative labor and production, but also decentralizes money as the only resource of value. The work is presented in marketing partnership with Dance/NYC, an advocacy organization for New York City dance, and creative collaboration with Our Goods, a barter network for the creative community.
